



BANGKOK CLASSIC TOUR

DAY 1 | ARRIVAL BANGKOK

After landing at Bangkok International Airport, a tour representative will meet and greet you before guiding you to the transfer to your hotel. Then spend the rest of this first day at leisure. Overnight in Bangkok in hotel Century Park or similar, 4*

DAY 2 | HALF-DAY ROYAL GRAND PALACE & TEMPLE TOUR

After breakfast, prepare to spend half a day exploring three of the most important Buddhist temples in Bangkok. Begin at Wat Traimit, also known as the temple of the Golden Buddha, which houses a 3-metre-tall statue made from solid gold and that weighs 5.5 tonnes. Then pass through Chinatown on your way to Wat Pho, the temple of the Reclining Buddha and home to the Chedis of the Kings. This 46-metre-long and 15-metre-high Buddha is the largest in Bangkok, and it illustrates the passing of the Buddha into nirvana. The Grand Palace, former residence of the Kings of Bangkok, is one of the most beautiful examples of an ancient Siamese court. Here you will see a variety of palaces used for different occasions: the Funeral Palace, the Reception Palace, the Throne Hall, the Coronation Hall, the Royal Guest House, and the beautiful Emerald Buddha Temple. To round off the tour, call in at a local lapidary factory and showroom where you will be able to get locally made jewelry, handicrafts and silk at competitive prices. Note: The Grand Palace is closed during special royal ceremonies and during visiting heads of state. Overnight in Bangkok in hotel Century Park or similar, 4*



DAY 3 | FULL-DAY FLOATING MARKET AND RAILWAY MARKET TOUR WITH SEAFOOD LUNCH

Today breakfast is followed by the discovery of the world's most famous floating market: Damnoen Saduak. On the way, make a stop at a Coconut Sugar Farm. Look around the farmhouse, see how they process the coconut sugar, and taste some of their freshly prepared products. Then head out to the floating market by long-tailed boat, sightseeing along the canal. Once in the market, watch the merchants as they paddle along the congested canals in sturdy canoes laden with fresh fruits and vegetables to sell to shoppers on the river bank. Continue then to the Conservation Mangrove Centre, where you have the chance to see monkeys in the wild. After lunch at a seafood restaurant in Don Hoi Lot (included), continue to the Maeklong Railway Market. See the fact-paced action that takes over the station in the few minutes before the train is due to pass through the market. The process happens so quickly it seems a miracle no one gets hurt. Overnight in Bangkok in hotel Century Park or similar, 4*

DAY 4 | DEPARTURE BANGKOK

Breakfast at the hotel before enjoying some free time for you to spend at leisure before the unescorted transfer back to Bangkok Airport, where you'll catch your onward flight to your following destination.
